

The children will follow the Fflic a Fflac scheme as well as the Flintshire County Council Language continuum to develop Welsh in English medium primary schools.




MATHEMATICS AND NUMERACY

- Division


We will also explore the following and link them to our topic:

RVE


We will be following the newly published 'Lighting the Path' scheme of work.

Important information for you to know:

- P.E:

How to help at home:

Here are some additional suggestions which may be useful...

Encourage your child to... -Share their ideas or news with family members. - Listen carefully to questions and then answer with an appropriate answer. -Use correct past tense when speaking e.g. bought not buyed, swam not swimmied.	Help your child to... -Read/share a range of texts at home. -Visit the library and locate books to find information. -Use a range of strategies in order to read independently. -Answer questions about their book and express opinions. -Read their reading book from school and return it, signed by an adult, when finished.	Encourage your child to... -Use full stops, capital letters and question marks accurately. -Use neat handwriting with correct letter formation. -Ensure your child uses a Capital letter at the beginning of their name.

Through the term your child will be taught to develop their mathematical skills in a variety of ways.

Using & applying	Number	Shape, Space & Measure	Handling data
Encourage your child to... -Check their answers. -Use mathematical symbols correctly. -Talk about and explain their work.	Help your child to... -Recognise numbers up to 100. - Order numbers. -Practise number bonds.	Encourage your child to... -Recognise 2D shapes and name them. -Recognise o'clock and times of daily routines e.g bedtime.	Help your child to... -Answer questions and interpret information presented in simple tables and tally charts.
