

Maths: Each maths lesson will consist of a 20-minute arithmetic session where we will practise our calculations and number skills. After this, we will then use these skills and apply them to solve problems. It is our hope that with this continued structure, it will develop our resilience and perseverance whilst creating a positive mindset towards Maths. Children will also have a times tables test every Friday. Over this term we will be focusing on:

- Number and Place Value
- Addition and Subtraction
- Multiplication and Division
- Fractions, Decimals and Percentages.
- Ratio and proportion.



RE: Our first topic is 'Loving', where children may begin to understand the church which is 'nothing other than the family of God'. Then we move onto Baptism/Confirmation, learning how people are given the gift of the Holy Spirit and are called to respond in their lives. We will then celebrate multi-faith week studying Judaism. Finally, as we approach the end of the Autumn Term we'll be reflecting upon the significance of Jesus' birth throughout Advent.

'Changes'



This is an outline of the learning planned for your child in the Autumn term, so you can, if you wish, enhance learning in school and at home. Please note it may be changed as learning is influenced and directed by the children in lessons.

PSHE: Citizenship and self awareness.

PE: Rounders skills and creative games skills alongside dance units with Mrs Denton.

Music: Composers from different eras and a unit called 'happy' with the elements of listening, appraising, singing and composing.



English: We aim to explore many new texts during our English and Guided Reading lessons. We will use these to explore the various themes within the text, looking at the features and using our knowledge to inform our writing both as a class and later, individually. We will also use the texts to provide a solid foundation of punctuation, spelling and grammar.

During this term we will be looking at:

- Information texts
- Biography
- Flashbacks-Nowhere Emporium
- Poetry about locations
- Classic Text – wizard of Oz



History: Our History topic this term, will focus on the changes in crime and punishment from 1066 to now.

Geography: We will be looking at geographical changes to our world, coastal formation and erosion.

Art/DT: Running alongside our History topic, in Art we will explore changes in art/artists over the 20th century. We will look at artwork by Salvador Dali, Warhol and Banksy (Surrealism, Pop Art and Graffiti)

Computing: This term our focus will be online safety is a special unit of work considering our digital footprint, screen time and personal data including location information.

Children will be using Purple Mash to complete lessons and children can access all the programs at home by using their log in if they would like to have further practise.
