

This is an outline of the learning planned for your child in the Spring term, so you can, if you wish, enhance learning in school and at home. Please note it may be changed as learning is influenced and directed by the children in lessons.


**RE:** We will study 3 topics over the Spring term -

**Sources- To learn from and about Holy Scriptures and the Bible**

The children will learn about the Bible as the story of God's love, told by the People of God.

**Unity – Holy Communion, & Eucharist-** The children will learn about the Eucharist challenges and how it enables the Christian family to live and grow in communion every day.

**Death & New life – Easter** :The Church's seasons of Lent, Holy Week and Easter; the suffering, death and resurrection of Jesus led to new life.



During this term we will continue to practise daily calculation skills in our 20-minute arithmetic sessions. After this, we will then use these skills and apply them to solve problems. It is our hope that with this continued structure, it will develop our resilience and perseverance whilst creating a positive mindset towards Maths. Over the Spring term we will be focusing on:

- Measures (area, perimeter & volume), time, money, sequences, order of operations, geometry, 2D & 3D shapes (incl- coordinates, translation, reflection) and statistics.

**Art:** The children will be learning about the artist Glen Alps. To make a collagraph relief printing block using card pieces and/or string to make rune lettering or Viking pattern designs.

**DT:** On our DT day this term, we will be learning how to design and make a torch with a switch.

**Music:** Our unit this term is called 'Classroom jazz' we will explore how music is created, produced and communicated, including by learning and playing the recorder.



During the Spring term, we will be swimming for the first 2 weeks then we will develop games skills on Thursday afternoons and on Wednesday afternoons we will be practising our gymnastics and dancing skills with Mrs Denton! Also of course enjoying our outdoor activities on our visits to the woods every 3 weeks.

## Class 5 Topic Spring 2026 *Let's Explore*



This year, Year 6 Children will be taught Mrs Mussell and Year 5 children will be taught by Miss Lynch. In the Spring term the focus is on physical sciences. Year 6 pupils will be focusing on Light and Electricity. Year 5 pupils will be focusing on Earth in Space and Forces.

**PSHE –** The topics taught will focus on control and respecting others, building relationships and improving memory. **Enrichment week** – will also enhance our learning across all subjects.



During our English and Guided reading lessons, we will use a variety of texts to explore the various themes, look at the features and use our knowledge to inform our writing both as a class and later, individually. Throughout our lessons, we will use texts to provide a solid foundation for the teaching of punctuation, spelling and grammar. During the Spring term we will be looking at:

Nonfiction texts about the environment – biographies, information, argument texts and persuasive writing.

Fiction- Shakespeare and Mystery stories.

**History:** Our History topic this term, we will focus on learning about the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England



**Geography:** We will be looking at and learning about mountains, how they are formed and where they are found around the world.

**Computing:** Throughout the year we will always focus on 'E-Safety' throughout all our lessons as well as learning about 'blogging'.

**French:** children will learn to understand and talk in French about 'Our precious planet.'
