

**Maths:** Each maths lesson will consist of a 20-minute arithmetic session where we will practise our calculations and number skills.

**RE:** Our first topic is The Eucharist and we will focus on giving and receiving. When we celebrate the Eucharist, Jesus gives himself to us in Word and Sacrament. We are called to follow the example of Jesus by giving ourselves to others in the world. Next, we will move onto Pentecost and how we can serve God. On the day of Pentecost, the Apostles spoke to the gathered people in the power of the Holy Spirit. St. Paul continued this work and we continue it today. Finally, we will explore the Sacrament of Reconciliation. In order for bridges to be built, a person has to acknowledge wrongdoing, so as to be reconciled to others and to God.

**PE:** Striking and Fielding games (cricket), Gymnastics, Dance, Cross Country and outdoor and adventurous activities.



**French:** School life. Children will learn key vocabulary related to objects, subjects and prepositional language.

**PSHE:** Y4 - exploring life cycles & changes, personal relationships. Y5 – exploring the world of work and money. RSHE will also continue throughout the term.

**Science:** We will be exploring living things and their habitats. Y4 will also learn about sound.



**English:** We aim to explore many new texts during our English and Guided Reading lessons. We will explore various themes within a text, look at the key features and use this knowledge to inform our own writing. We will also use texts to provide a solid foundation of punctuation, spelling and grammar.

During this term we will be looking at:

- Fairy Tales
- Newspaper reports (recounts)
- A novel with a theme of Inventions
- Hybrid information texts.

**History:** Our History topic this term, will focus on the ancient Mayan civilisation.

**Geography:** Study of the Americas - land use, physical and human features, economic activity, resources, settlements, trade links, etc. This will include lots of world map work.

**Art/DT:** Children will design and create a rainforest bean bag animal. These will be sewed using different stitches and decorated with beads, sequins, ribbon and more.

**Music:** Learning will be focused around 'Dancing in the Street' by Martha And The Vandellas. Our composer for the term will be Steve Reich (Contemporary).

**Computing:** Animation on Purple Mash (using tools like 2Animate). Children will learn to create digital moving images by producing, editing, and sequencing frames. Every lesson will have an 'E-Safety' focus. We will also continue to use the I-pads and laptops in other lessons!

Children can access all the programs at home by using their personal log in for Purple Mash (in the front of reading records).
