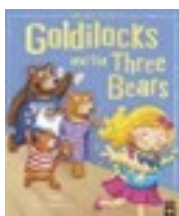


Once Upon A Time!

Literacy

We will...

- Read a book with an adult.
- Identifies environmental sounds and can copy / repeat sounds.
- Mark make and draw with a range of tools and equipment.



Expressive Arts and Design

We will...

- Join in with nursery rhymes.
- Listen with increasing attention to sounds e.g. animal noises.
- Draw using closed shapes and lines to represent animals and objects.
- Develop stories using 'small world' equipment.



Communication and Language

We will...

- Start to listen to adults around us and will respond to very simple requests.
- Start to communicate through words and gestures.



Physical Development

We will...

- Use strength to move from one thing to another.
- Use a range of tools and equipment.



Maths

We will...

- Start to use some number names and starts to ascribe names to objects in a rhythmic way.
- Counts rhythmically to 5 and can count in songs and rhymes.
- Sort using simple criteria.



Personal, Social and Emotional

We will...

- Know what is expected in school and have some awareness of ourselves and others.
- Form attachments with adults in the setting.
