We are excited to let you know that on Friday 28th November, we will be holding a Great Fire of London Theme Day for all children in Key Stage 1.

This special day will be filled with enriching, hands-on activities across subjects including Art, Design Technology, Maths, and History, all linked to their History topic: The Great Fire of London. Children will be working off-timetable and immersed in practical learning experiences throughout the day.

To help bring the theme to life, we invite children to come dressed in a simple costume inspired by the 1666 period. These do not need to be expensive or elaborate—homemade options work wonderfully!

Here are some easy ideas:

- A large plain shirt with a wide collar, a belt or cord around the waist, a plain waistcoat (if available), dark baggy trousers (e.g. tracksuit bottoms) tucked into long plain socks, and comfortable shoes.
- A plain shirt with a wide collar, a long plain skirt, an apron, flat sturdy shoes, and a plain white headscarf.

Throughout the day, children will deepen their understanding of the Great Fire of London through creative and engaging activities that support their historical learning.
