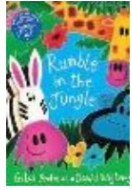
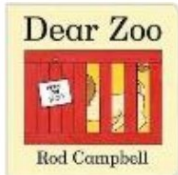


# Walking around the Zoo!

## Literacy

We will...

- Talk about the pictures in stories.
- Identify instrumental sounds and will copy/repeat some.
- Make marks and add meaning to these.



## Expressive Arts and Design

We will...



- Join in with nursery rhymes.
- Listen with increasing attention to sounds e.g. animal noises.
- Draw using closed shapes and lines to represent animals and objects.
- Develop stories using 'small world' equipment.

## Communication and Language

We will...

- Be able to listen and respond to a simple request or instruction.
- Use regular plural forms regularly in sentences e.g. "is", "are", "am".



## Physical Development

We will...

- Use a wide range of tools and show some control over these.



## Maths

We will...

- Identify 1, 2 and 3 objects.
- Start to use number comparison language.
- Talk about their models and what we used to build them.



## Personal, Social and Emotional

We will...

- Gain likes and dislikes.
- Show awareness that things don't always go our way—we will have more flexibility when things are different.
- Play alongside other children.
