Class 1

Spring 2026 Overview

English:

Children will read 'Little Red Reading Hood'. They will create sentences using capital letters, finger spaces, adjectives and full stops.

Children will read "Seasons" and learn about features of information texts.

Top Tip: Children can write shopping lists, notes, treasure hunt clues and birthday cards to develop their confidence in writing at home.

Maths: YR Children will learn to count reliably with numbers from 1 to 5. They will learn about shapes with four sides.

Top Tip: Sing counting songs and rhymes such as '1,2,3,4,5 once I caught a fish alive' to help children develop an understanding of number.

Y1: Children will learn to count reliably to 20 in numerals and words. They will learn about Place value, tens and ones. They will learn to measure the length of objects, as well as capacity and mass.

Top tip: Spot numbers to 20 on walks, such as house numbers.

Y2: Will learnt to multiply and divide by 2, 5 and 10. They will learn to measure the length and height of objects, as well as capacity and mass.

Top tip: Practise counting aloud in 2's, 5's and 10's.

PSHE: Children are learning about their rights and respecting others. They will also learn about basic first aid.

Top Tip: Talk about how we show respect for our belongings at home.



Art/DT: Children will explore mixing colours, paint with colour and print with paint.

R.E: The children will learn about Celebrations and why they are important to different people. They will learn about how Easter is important for Christian people. They will learn how Holi is important for Hindu people.

Top tip: Go outside and spot signs of spring and new life. Discuss what your family celebrate over the year and how you do this.

Computing: Children will be learning about programming Beebots using Algorithms. They will learn how to give clear instructions.

Top Tip: Play "Robots" at home! One person gives a directional instruction and the other must follow them without crashing!

Music: Children will listen to music thinking about the world around us. Children will learn to listen with an understanding that some music comes from different historical periods. Children will learn that music can tell a story.

Top tip: Listen and dance to music at home or in the car! Sing along to old favourites or nursery rhymes. Clapping and dancing to the rhythm together can help children understand the beat!

Top tip: Children can listen to: <https://video.link/w/9C40>. This song illustrates which primary colours make each secondary colour.

Science: Children will learn about the importance for humans to exercise, to eat the right amounts of different types of food and the importance of good hygiene.

Top tip: At mealtimes you could discuss the different food groups on your plate and why they are good for your bodies. You could go out and do a physical activity together, like riding bikes or playing and running at the park.

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
