

English:

We will be:

- Reading quality texts such as Shackleton's Journey, and using them to inspire our own writing
- Learning about different sentence types and using them in our writing confidently
- Learning to use conjunctions to extend our sentences
- Learning to use different suffixes to create new words
- Writing for different purposes, eg writing our own 'Ship Logs'!

PE:

This half term we will be continuing to develop gymnastics skills. We will also be practising skipping skills and learning tricks!

Science:

This half term our topic is "Living Things and Their Habitats." We will be:

- Learning about different habitats
- Identifying and naming different plants and animals in their habitat, including microhabitats
- Creating simple food chains

Music:

This half term our units are: Storytime and Seasons. The children will be focusing on exploring sounds through the use of different stories as a prompt as well as the different seasons. The children will also be learning about pitch.

Computing:

In computing we will be:

- Inputting data
- Creating pictograms
- Presenting information

Spanish

In Spanish we will be:

- Learning about different foods and drinks
- Role playing café scenes

Design Technology:

We will be designing and creating structures. We will be making a throne for Max in the story of "Where the Wild Things Are"

Food Technology:

We will be looking at the food that explorers would have eaten and sampling examples.

Humanities:

This half term we will be:

- Using maps and globes to explore the journeys of famous explorers
- Using geographical words to describe place and direction
- Thinking about how expeditions from the past are remembered
- Using sources to find out more about the past

Maths:

In our maths lessons we will be learning about:

- Multiplication and division (learning number facts for 2, 5 and 10 times tables)
- Measuring length and height
- Learning about mass, capacity and temperature.

RE:

In RE this half term we will have two units, both based on Christianity. These units will be focused on answering the questions:

- Why are women so important in the Bible?
- Do Easter symbols help us to understand Easter?

PSHE:

Our Jigsaw topic this half term is 'Healthy Me'. We will be thinking about our health and wellbeing, and how to look after ourselves.
