Spanish

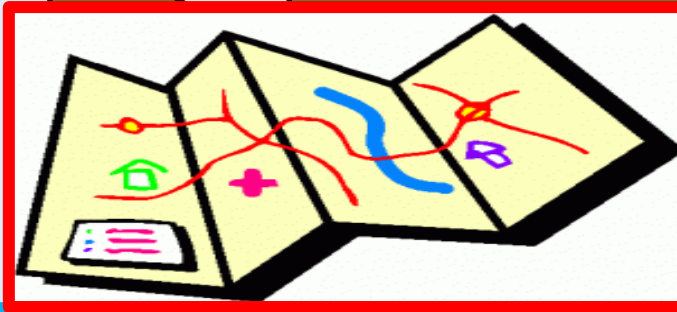
This half term we will be
