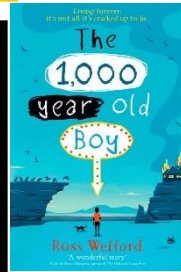
Branch 5: To the ends of the Earth

Science

Living Things and Their Habitats: Life Cycles and Reproduction

The children will describe the life cycles of plants, mammals, birds, amphibians and insects. Working scientifically, they will observe and compare equivalent parts of flowers and use data to describe a relationship and make predictions.

Music

Changes in pitch, tempo and dynamics: Rivers

In this unit the children will learn to sing in tune and play a piece of music based on the theme of rivers. They will create an ostinato and represent it on paper.

PE

Swimming and Net and Wall
