Important

Labelled suitcase/ holdall

- Clothes for 5 days- comfortable, jeans, tops etc.. Not a fashion show – going to be out and about
- Extra clothes for theme park day
- Extras – get wet/ dirty at the park etc..
- Sensible shoes or trainers – a lot of walking!
- Shorts, t-shirts
- Sun cream, hat
- Waterproof coat
- P.Js and anything they need for bedtime
- Toiletries
- Towels – these are not provided by the hotel (a couple, often get wet or dirty!)
- Plastic bags to put wet/ dirty clothing in
- Swimming costume etc...
- **Back pack/ rucksack (on coach)**
- Packed lunch (for Monday)
- Named water bottle (to be refilled daily)
- Snacks and drinks
- Named purse / wallet – Monday money only!
- Travel games, books, cards etc...
- Pillow/ cushion, blanket for snoozing on the coach!
- **NO phones, ipads etc.. Anything that can be connected to the internet to be taken.**

Kit List



Group leaders

- Children will be put into groups prior to the trip, they will be assigned a group leader
- These are purely for admin purposes, children will remain as a larger group
- Group leader is your point of contact prior to departure-ensure your group leader has any relevant information
- Medicines – these need to be clearly labelled and handed to group leader on Friday prior to departure (or before). They will administer as necessary. Please have discussions prior to Sunday evening! Can pack calpol etc and give permission on form to administer as required
- Money- children only have money for each day. Place money for each day in a labelled envelope and hand to group leader Friday before departure (or earlier) They will give this out to the children each morning. Money can roll over!

Monday – money should be in your child’s purse / wallet already and in their back pack. Approx. £5-£10, breakfast on the ferry.
