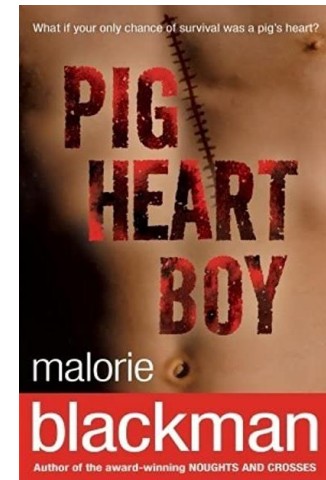
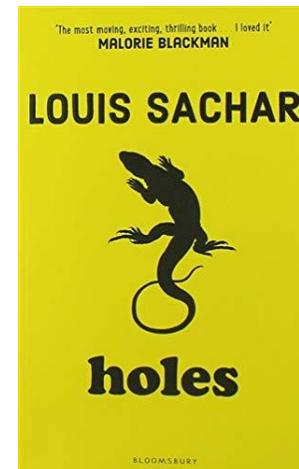
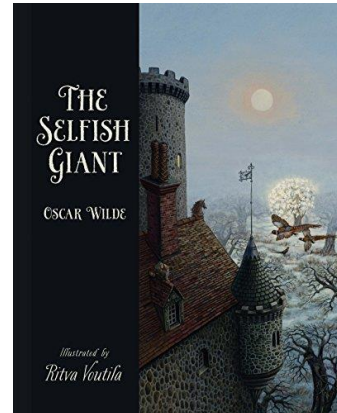
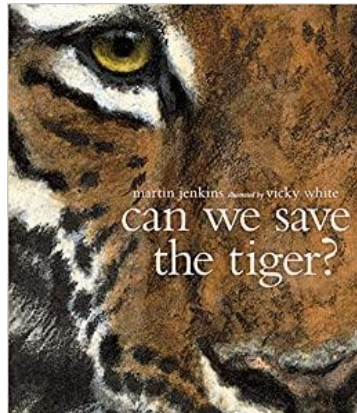
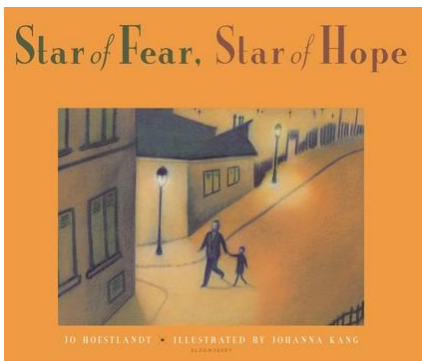
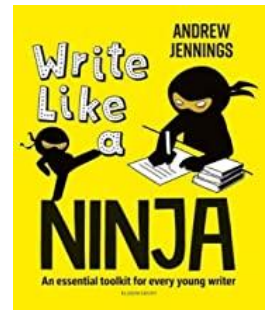
Routines

Whole-class approach based on a wide range of texts/stimuli

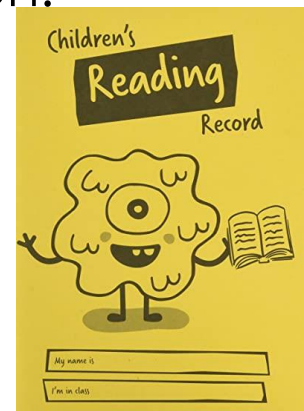

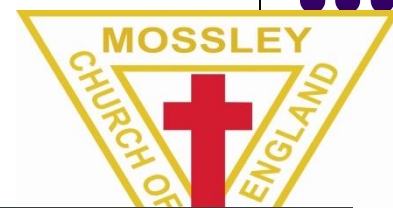
Guided reading - every afternoon in school

Encourage reading for pleasure at home, listen and question.

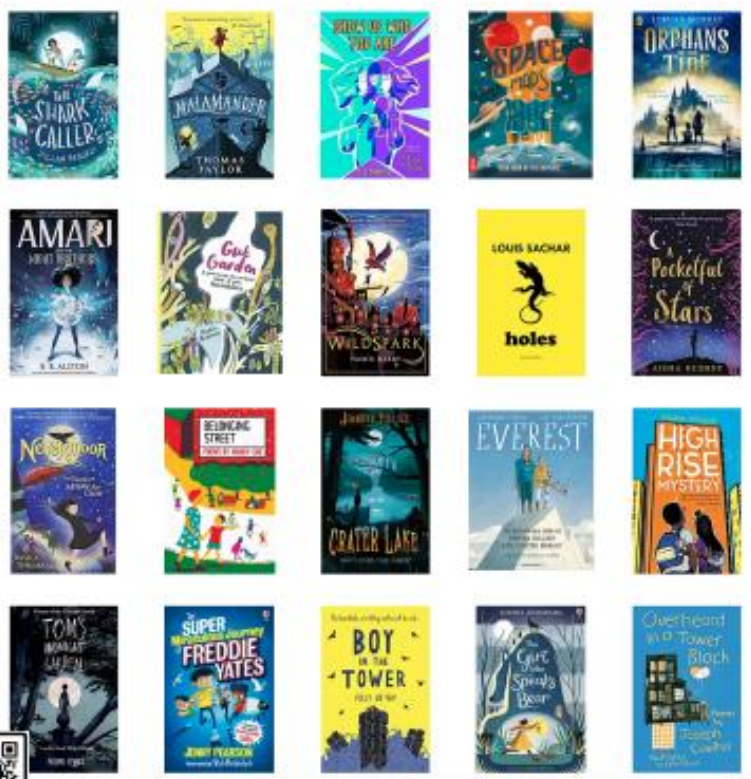

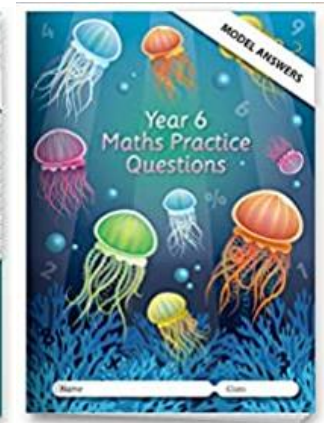
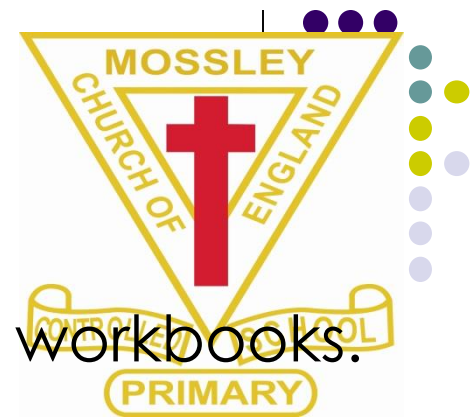
Assessment/ SATs

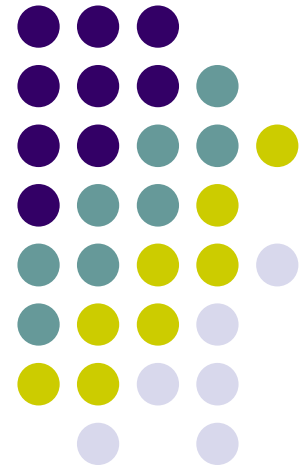

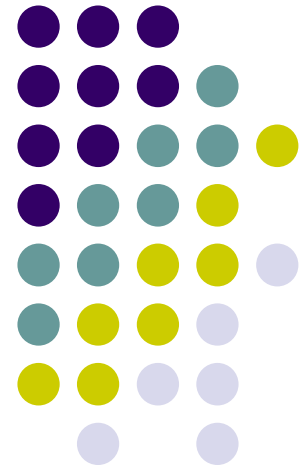
