Important

Labelled suitcase/ holdall

- Clothes for 5 days- comfortable, jeans, tops etc.. Not a fashion show – going to be out and about
- Extra clothes for theme park day
- Extras – get wet/ dirty at the park etc..
- Sensible shoes or trainers – a lot of walking!
- Shorts, t-shirts
- Sun cream, hat
- Waterproof coat
- P.Js and anything they need for bedtime
- Toiletries
- Towels – these are not provided by the hotel (a couple, often get wet or dirty!)
- Plastic bags to put wet/ dirty clothing in

Kit List



Group leaders

- Children will be put into groups prior to the trip, they will be assigned a group leader
- These are purely for admin purposes, children will remain as a larger group
- Group leader is your point of contact prior to departure- ensure your group leader has any relevant information
- Medicines – these need to be clearly labelled and handed to group leader on Friday prior to departure (or before). They will administer as necessary. Please have discussions prior to Sunday evening! Can pack calpol etc and give permission on form to administer as required
- Money- see next slide!

Groups and group leaders



Children to have card – Revolut, Starling, Monzo, Post Office etc...

We have encountered lots of issues with cash- football stadium will not take cash, ferry crossing cash only.

Card to be handed to group leader – they will look after them! Card in an envelope with how much money will be available for each day

Top up each evening –managed back at home.

Monday –Approx. £10, breakfast on the ferry.
€10-15 for souvenirs

Tuesday- spends for souvenirs €15-20

Wednesday –spends for souvenirs at Clara Maria €15-20, De Kuip – dependant on what they would like to purchase. Please let us know if they will be getting a repli top.

Thursday – spends for souvenirs, ice-creams at Dunirell €15-20

Friday – spends for chocolates. Money for tea at service station.
