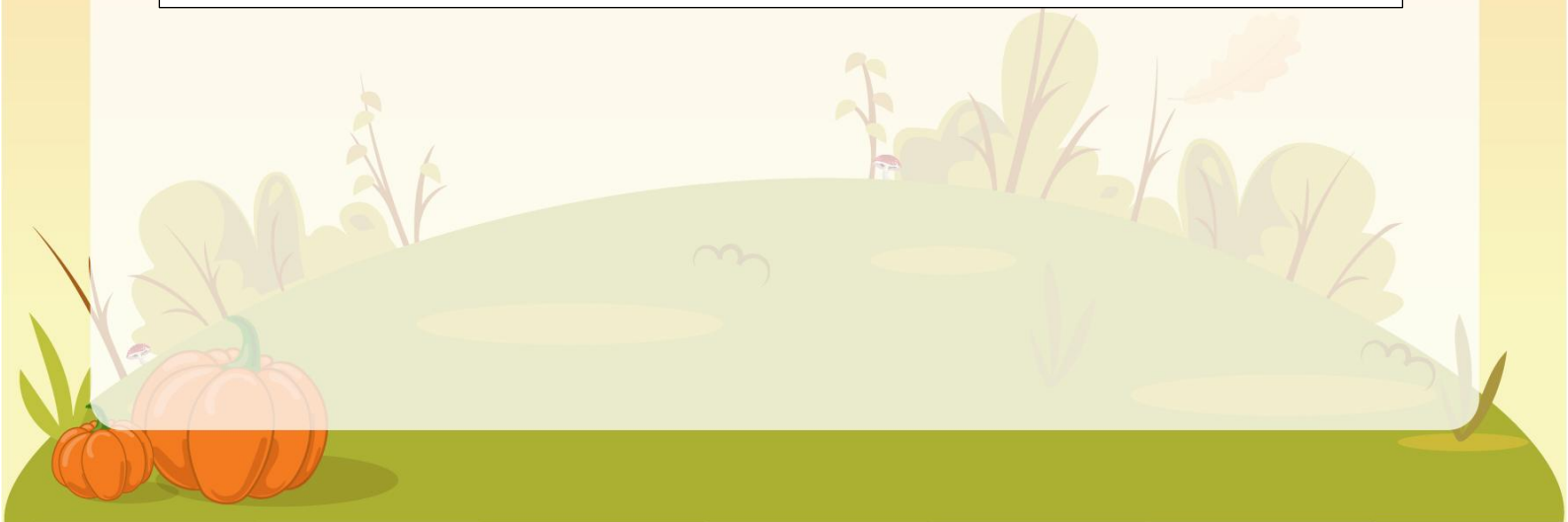
Harvest
