Look out for our planters around town and the Mayor proudly presented us with certificates too. Miss Munro and Mrs Ayre loved getting stuck in!

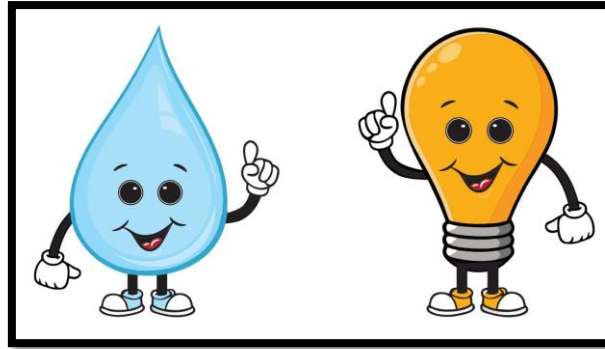


### Switch Off Campaign characters.
