Maths	English	Topic
Create a timeline for someone in your family. Find out about key events in their lives and use either photographs or drawings to illustrate these.	Find out about a famous building in the local area – when was it built? What was it built for? Has it been used for different things over the years? Who designed it? Present your findings to the class.	Choose something that you are interested in doing in your own time and prepare a short talk about it. You might want to bring in things to show the class about your hobby or sport or even to create a poster or powerpoint presentation.
Make sure that you can count back from any number between 10 and 100. If there are any that you don't know, try to think of a clever way of learning them – try playing noughts and crosses, writing them in lots of different colours, building them up one letter at a time or thinking of a rhyming word that will help you to remember them.	Draw or paint a picture by observing a plant in or near your house.
