Make sure to describe each area in your house and explain why you have included it. If you can, use recycled materials to build a model.
Practise ordering numbers up to 1,000,000. Create a variety of number lines and place numbers in order in both ascending and descending order.	Create a set of instructions to make one of your favourite meals at home. Follow those instructions and show us the end results.	Plant a seed of your choice and create a photo/sketch diary to show how it changes over time.
