Maths	English	Topic
Pyramids were made with stone blocks in layers in a square arrangement. One layer on top of the next getting smaller as they got to the top. Work out how many blocks are used for: 3 blocks high base (3x3 blocks) 4 blocks high 5 blocks high – challenge 10 blocks	Imagine you are Howard Carter and you have just discovered King Tut's tomb. Write a letter to your sister describing the discovery and how you are feeling. Don't forget to write it in the present tense.	Write a set of instructions for the Egyptian game Senet. You may also want to make the game so you can play it with your friends. You may need to research what this game was.
Research the Ancient Egyptian number system. Write it out. For extension, create some number and word sentences using them.	Choose an Ancient God and create a fact file about them. Try to include at least 5 facts – (appearance, name, what they are known for etc)	Create your own tomb or sarcophagus for a mummy. Remember they are decorated with a picture of the person and shows off their wealth.
Play TTrackstars 2 or 3 times per week. https://play.ttrockstars.com	Write a poem or a story about the Ancient Egyptians – think about how they lived and remember to write in clear sentences.	Research the Ancient Egyptian hieroglyphic alphabet and write them out. Then create your own and use it to write your name.
Find number facts related to Ancient Egypt. For example, how many pyramids? The length of the Nile, the age of Tutankhamun became king etc.	Create a picture diagram of Ancient Egyptian facts.	Draw a landscape picture of a scene from Ancient Egypt. You could include the River Nile or the pyramids.
