Maths	English	Topic
Set yourself the challenge to learn to count on and back in steps of equal size, so you can count on and back in 2's 5's and 10's from any different number. For an added challenge can you count on and back in steps of 3?	Find out about an author of your choice. Learn about what inspires them to write. See if you can find a website or even make contact with them yourself. Be prepared to share some books – you may want to put pictures of these onto a PowerPoint.	Create a PowerPoint or poster to show us how a religion of your choice celebrates different festivals. You could include photos or images copied from the internet. Don't forget to make sure that the font you choose stands out from the background. You will be able to present completed PowerPoints to the class.
Prepare a short shopping list, then go to the shops to buy the items on it using real money. https://www.topmarks.co.uk/money/toy-shop-money	Write a letter to the product manager in a large supermarket to convince them of the benefits of only stocking locally sourced produce.	Create a letter of thank you to the staff at Chester Zoo for helping us during our school visit. Don't forget to include your favourite parts of the day If you bring your letter into school we will post these to the zoo – they usually send us a little thank you to those who do write.

Remember to give little hints about exciting parts of the book without telling us the whole story.	Do something at home to reduce your carbon footprint. Ask questions about new vocabulary, See if they can predict what might happen next, can they explain how a character might be feeling and use clues in the text to 'prove it'?
