Write 3 multiplication word problems about the Aztecs (with answers) using x3 x4 or x8 times tables.	Design an advertisement to market Mexico City. You can choose to present your advert in anyway you choose, for example, a short film, presentation, powerpoint, poster or leaflet.	Make some basic instruments (a shaker or drum). Compose you own piece of music. You can choose your own style or be inspired by the Aztecs.
Design a multiplication game using at least 3 of the multiplication tables we have covered (x2,x3,x4,x5,x8 and x10).	Choose an Aztec God and create a fact file about them. Try to include at least 5 facts – (appearance, , name, known for etc)	Choose any piece of music without lyrics. Create and perform a simple routine. Consider the elements or height, speed and direction. This can be done alone or in a group of upto 4 members.
Write 3 number sentences using the Aztec number system. https://youngzones.org/ElaineTAMUCC/FMN/Aztec_number.html	Write a poem or a story about the Aztecs. Think about their inventions and way of life!	With a partner write 5 questions to ask an Aztec God. You will then decide who will be the God and who is the Interviewer. Role play the interview in front of the class
Write a list of the Aztec number system using their symbols. https://youngzones.org/ElaineTAMUCC/FMN/Aztec_number.html	Create a spider diagram of Aztec facts. Present it in any imaginative way you like.	Chose an artefact or building to create (for example, jewelery or temple). You can use any media to make it, for example, modeling clay, lego, junk models, paintings or drawings.
