Fidget toys and Calming Items

At Etchells we are proud to be an inclusive school. We strive to limit barriers to learning and ensure that neurodivergent pupils can access all lessons. Sometimes fidget toys can help ease anxieties and aid focus for some pupils. It is important though that they are only used as planned in agreement with the class teacher and SENCo so that they do not themselves become a further barrier to learning. Where they help ease anxiety/boost focus and are used in accordance with reviewed SEND plans, they can be a big help. In other circumstances they can be a distraction. Teachers will use their professional judgment. Please ask if you have any questions about how to best support your child.
