Foundation

We do many exciting topics in Year 3/4 which enable us to cover all aspects of the curriculum.

Our topic this term is called 'Digging up the Past'. This is a history based topic in which we will be learning all about Ancient Civilisations with a focus on The Ancient Egyptians. We will make lots of links to other areas of the curriculum.



English

Our English will be based around the short film, The Blue Umbrella. The children will be developing their sentence stacking skills through this medium. They will also be writing a non-chronological report on their science topic, Animals, including Humans. We will also be continuing to work on our spellings and phonics.

Maths

We will be continuing our work on multiplication and division, and will complete units, length, perimeter and fractions. This year the children need to learn to tell the time to the nearest minute on an analogue and a digital twelve hour clock. Please practise this skill at home.



Computing

Miss Copley, who is a computing specialist, will be delivering lessons to all children this term. She will cover programming and coding. The children use a programme called Scratch.

Homework

Curriculum - The children will be given six challenges. They need to complete two of the six challenges, one creative and one written task by February half term.

Reading - Your child will read every day each week in a whole class reading session. Their independent book to share at home will be changed when they finish it. They will also bring home a library book to read independently or share with the family. Please ensure that you sign in their reading diary each week when you have read with your child.

Spellings - We work on a range of spellings each week in class, you can help at home by using the 1/2 spelling list or 3/4 spelling list to rehearse some of the words that your child is unsure about. These lists can be found on our school website.

Times Tables - Year 3 need to be confident with the x2, x3, x4, x5, x8 and x10 and Year 4 need to know all the multiplication times tables up to 12x12 ready for the Times Tables Test in June which all Year 4 children take to assess their knowledge.

Behaviour - We will be continuing to use Class Dojo as our reward system. The children will earn dojos for working hard, helping others, good manners etc. The children will work towards a whole class treat when 4000 dojos are achieved.

PE

Snacks
