September Class information

Classes for September are finalised and teachers will communicate to parents early next week which teacher your child will have from September. In KS1 and year 3 this is very straightforward. It is a little more complicated for years 4, 5 and 6 because the year 4s will be back to 2 classes (having been spread across 3 y3/4 classes this year) and there will be a discrete year 5 class, a mixed 5/6 class and a discrete year 6 class. If your child is in y5 in September and will be in the mixed class you will already have been informed.

Our re-scheduled sports day is taking place on Friday 19th June. Reception and KS2 will have their sports day in the morning, with KS1 taking part in the afternoon. Nursery have a separate sports day on Wednesday 24th June. We hope you can come along to cheer them on.



Collection by teenagers

Children in years 5 and 6 can, with their parents' written permission, walk home by themselves. For younger children, we require that they are collected by a known, responsible adult. We have had requests for older children to collect younger ones but we cannot agree to this as we are legally responsible for the children until they are back with their parents (or a known responsible adult). Children below y5 must be collected by a known responsible adult which may include a known, responsible adolescent of 16 years or over but not anyone younger than this.
